

HOT LUNCH FAQ

What is hot lunch?

Hot lunch is a program that was created to give the children and teachers an alternative to sack lunch at least 2x per month where scheduling permits.

What is the cost?

The program is at a cost of \$3.00 per child. Envelopes will be provided to each family in order to prepare in advance.

How do I volunteer?

There is a sign-up sheet located at the front desk as you walk into the school. The menu is pre-selected by date and done so to help with budgeting and scheduling. If you want to bring something different than what is listed on the menu please give a minimum of 2 weeks notice and make sure that your meal can be prepared within budget (see below).

Who prepares the meals?

The program is strictly run by parent volunteers. When signed up for a "hot lunch" Friday the parent that signed up is responsible for purchasing the ingredients needed to make the dish, preparing and bringing the dish to school, set up prior the children's lunch and serving.

How many do I need to serve?

We would ask that you prepare enough for approximately 30 servings. This will allow all of our children and teachers to eat. This will also cover any additional servings some of the older children may want.

Will I get reimbursed for my expenses?

Yes, please turn in your receipt to Monica Elizondo and you will be reimbursed the cost of the meal to include a side and dessert. So that we can stick to a budget we ask that you keep your costs to \$50.00 or below. Supplies such as plates, napkins, utensils and drink mix are provided by ACE and will not need to be purchased by the parent volunteer.

Where can I find the additional supplies needed?

All of the supplies listed above can be found in the lunchroom kitchen in cabinets or on shelves located to the left of the kitchen. These should be clearly marked.

What time should I arrive?

The children eat lunch at 12:15 so give yourself enough time to set up that will allow them to stay on schedule. The kids will have kitchen duties where they clean up the tables and floors but the volunteer is responsible for cleaning whatever they used in the kitchen are.
